

## Host Responsibility Policy

The management and staff of Forest Lodge believe that although we do not serve alcohol on our premises, we have a responsibility to provide an environment that is not only comfortable and welcoming but regulated where alcohol is present. Because of this, we have implemented the following Host Responsibility Policy.

We believe that it is everybody's responsibility to look after one another, whether it be family or friend, young or old. We will do our best to create a safe environment with minimal dangers, monitor intoxication levels to the best of our abilities, and respond appropriately to incidents that may arise due to unsafe drinking.

We ask that guests follow these guidelines in return:

Alcohol must not be consumed by guests over 18 years old unless supervised by a parent or caregiver.

Due to our remote location, emergency services are a long way away! This means it is crucial to be mindful of intoxication levels of you and your companions.

We have zero tolerance for aggressive, coercive or violent behaviour. Guests will be requested to leave if displaying these behaviours.

Ensure that your alcohol is stored in an appropriate and safe manner.
